We have already begun to reflect on the suggestions shared and have taken action where possible. One area highlighted was improving communication about your child's day-to-day learning and progress, alongside easier access to our Class Dojo platform. You should have received an invitation from your child's class teacher to sign up via email – if this is not the case please contact the school office. Please note that communication via Dojo has been restricted to school hours and will take place between 8:00am and 5:00pm on weekdays only. There will be no contact at weekends, as we are committed to supporting staff wellbeing and maintaining a healthy work-life balance.

Another theme raised was wanting greater clarity about what your child is learning throughout the year. We are pleased to share that your child's long-term curriculum plan is now available on the school website, and a copy will also be uploaded to the class Dojo page. Moving forward we will look at a way in which we can update you termly with more curricular detail.

While we already provide a rich, broad, and balanced curriculum, some responses asked for more trips and further afield outdoor learning opportunities. This is something we will continue to explore carefully. However, we are mindful of the current financial climate and are reluctant to place additional demands on families. Please be assured that we will consider creative and sustainable ways to enhance these requests.

Once again, thank you for your continued support and for sharing your views with us. We are still happy to receive further responses and value your ongoing partnership in supporting our school.
