Dear Parents / Guardians,

On Monday 11th May 2026 your child will sit their KS2 Statutory SATs. They have all worked so hard and are very well prepared for these tests. I am extremely proud of them and the progress they have made thus far. SATs will be administered in their classroom and the timetable runs as follows:

Monday:

English GPS Paper 1: Questions

English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling Paper 2: Spelling

Tuesday:

English Reading

Wednesday:

Mathematics Paper 1: Arithmetic

Mathematics Paper 2: Reasoning

Thursday:

Mathematics Paper 3: Reasoning

These tests will begin at 9am prompt every day and therefore it is vital that children arrive to school in plenty of time and **before 8.45am**.

To ensure all of the children arrive on time, feel settled and calm for the morning ahead we are inviting them to come into school from 8.20am Monday – Thursday. The children can access the Year 6 classroom by using the top gate next to the school carpark (as if they were going to Breakfast Club).

We will provide the children with breakfast (**up until 8.40am**) and teachers/ support staff will be present in class to help settle and prepare them. I would encourage all of you to allow your child to come to our “breakfast session” as it enables them to chat with friends, have any last-minute discussions with us and settle into a calm and quiet environment.

Those children who attend regular Breakfast Club will join us at 8.20am in the Year 6 classroom. Unfortunately, we are unable to offer this service to younger siblings and therefore they will need to attend school at the normal gate opening time 8.40am.
